

PRE-ORDER Fish for Pick-up Tuesday, September 17, 2024 2:00 - 3:00 pm

ORDER DEADLINE: Tuesday, September 10, 2024.

PICK-UP LOCATION: at the Mosquito Lake Parking Lot on McCleary Jacoby Road adjacent to Hillside Cemetery; GPS Coordinates: 41°19'47.65" N 80°44'30.07" W

Important Reminders:

- Bring suitable containers with heavy duty plastic liners (example: 5 gallon bucket with a 30 gallon heavy duty trash bag); NO SCENTED BAGS; THE BAGS ARE NECESSARY TO HOLD OXYGEN TO KEEP THE FISH ALIVE DURING TRANSPORT. Do not use a lid (it can create holes in the bag); use something like twine to tie the bag if needed
- Fill each container approximately 1/3 full with water from the pond that you plan on stocking the fish; NO WELL OR TAP WATER.
- General guidance: one container per 100 small fish, one container per 1,000 minnows; if white amurs or koi are ordered, plan no more than 2 amur or 2-3 koi per 5 gallon container.
- Fish should be taken directly to the pond after pick-up and placed into the pond (if your liner/bag is black or dark colored, please turn it inside out to ensure you have gotten all of the fish into the pond).
- All Sales Are Final with no guarantee of fish survival.
- Payment can be made by cash, check, or money order and must be paid when order is submitted by the deadline of September 10th.
